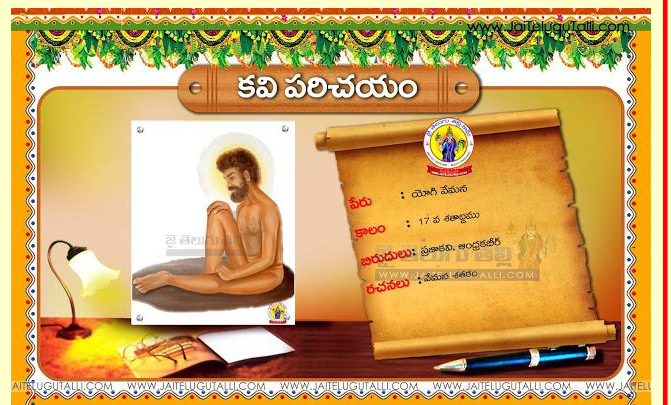


Volunteer Teachers Required
